ORDINANCE NO. 11072022E

AN ORDINANCE CREATING CHAPTER 9-5, OFFENSES AGAINST STATE LAWS SUBJECT TO FORFEITURE OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE TOWN OF EATON, BROWN COUNTY, WISCONSIN

THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF EATON, BROWN COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DOES ORDAIN THAT CHAPTER 9-5, OFFENSES AGAINST STATE LAW SUBJECT TO FORFEITURE BE CREATED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The following statutes following chapter 9-5 defining offenses against the peace and good order of the State are adopted by reference to define offenses against the peace and good order of the Town, provided the penalty for commission of such offenses hereunder shall be limited to a forfeiture, assessment and costs imposed under Section 23 of this Municipal Code. Any act required to be performed or prohibited by any statute incorporated herein by reference is required or prohibited by this chapter. Any future amendments, revisions or modifications of the statutes incorporated herein are intended to be made part of this Chapter.

Traffic Code Statues 341 to 348 including the Trans Statues TR 305 (equipment violations) – State Uniform Bond schedule - Except as otherwise specifically provided in this chapter, the statutory provisions or rules of the Department of Transportation in Chs. 340 to 348 and §941.01(1), Wis. Stats., describing and defining regulations with respect to vehicles and traffic, and Ch. 350, Wis. Stats., describing and defining regulations with respect to snowmobiles, inclusive of any provisions therein relating to penalties to be imposed and exclusive of any regulations for which the statutory penalty is a fine or term of imprisonment, are hereby adopted and by reference made a part of this chapter as if fully set forth herein. Any act required to be performed or prohibited by any statute or rules of the Department of Transportation incorporated herein by reference is required or prohibited by this chapter. Any future amendments, revisions or modifications of the statutes or rules of the Department of Transportation incorporated herein are intended to be made part of this chapter in order to secure uniform statewide regulation of traffic on the highways, streets, roads and alleys of Wisconsin.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its adoption and publication.
